



Dear Pastor / Ministry Leader,

Living Pure Ministries is a local ministry that aims to inform and equip young people with Biblical truth in relation to purity by encouraging them to love God with all of their heart, soul and mind. After speaking with several area youth leaders, once again we see the need to reach Lynchburg's youth through an area-wide conference.

A dual conference will be held at Liberty University on March 5, 2011, from 9:30 AM to 4:00 PM in DeMoss Hall, 1st floor (doors open at 8:30 AM). We will be repeating the young women's conference, "Beautiful from the Inside Out" and conducting a young men's conference ("Standing Strong") for ages 13 and up. Youth leaders, dads and moms are also encouraged to attend. We will open the day together in worship, and then men and women will have their own sessions tailored just for them throughout the day. Beside workshops for teens, we will have workshops specifically designed for youth leaders, moms and dads. In addition, for those who are interested, there will be a Special Certificate Commitment Service at the end of the day. This service is designed to give the teen an opportunity to make a public pledge for living a life of purity by signing a certificate with their parents or youth leader present. Many parents present their teen with a purity ring or symbol during this service.

We are offering an early registration fee of \$12.00 per person due by January 31, 2011. After January 31, 2011 the registration fee is \$15.00 per person. Registrations after February 21, 2011 will not be guaranteed a box lunch.

In addition, Liberty University is also offering one Continuing Education Unit (CEU) for this event. Those who attend this conference are eligible to obtain a CEU for an additional fee of \$25, which goes directly to Liberty University. The CEU is accepted nationally as a non-credit continuing education program. This 1.0 CEU is based on ten contact hours of participation, with six of the hours coming from the conference and four more hours from an individual work assignment. This is a great opportunity for Teachers, High School / College students, Social Workers, and anyone who would like to gain a CEU for professional development purposes. These courses usually cost around \$75.

We invite you to join us for this life-challenging event. We pray this conference will equip and encourage young people to live daily for Christ by committing to a life of purity. Our teens are bombarded with the idea that purity is something of the past and sexual permissiveness is completely acceptable. We cannot be silent!

We are excited to have many volunteers from our community helping with this event. It would be our privilege to serve with you in reaching young people through a Living Pure Conference.
